

WTA | YOUNG PROFESSIONALS AWARD

For outstanding achievements in the fields of building conservation and monument preservation, WTA International awards a prize to young professionals every year on the occasion of the WTA-Days.

- WTA-YPA Practical for practical works,
- WTA-YPA Educational for bachelor and master theses and
- WTA-YPA Scientific for doctoral theses and research works.

The winners of the WTA Young Professionals Award (WTA-YPA) will receive:

- the WTA trophy,
- the prize money of 500 EUR,
- membership in WTA for two years and
- the reimbursement of costs for participation in the WTA-Days (travel, accommodation and participation fee)

Professionals from craft, execution and science up to the age of 35 may apply for the WTA-YPA. Bachelor's, master's, diploma or doctoral theses, research reports, apprenticeship or master craftsman's final theses and project works, which are not older than 18 months at the time of the submission deadline are eligible.

At the award ceremony, the prize-winner will be given the opportunity to present the most important results of the work in a personal presentation. In addition, there is the possibility of publishing an article in Bausubstanz or a corresponding English-language journal.

A selection of the other submitted WTA-YPA entries will be recognised with a one-year WTA membership and presented at the WTA-Days with the posters created by participants.

Submission deadline for the WTA-YPA 2027 is 31. December 2026.
